Arctic Fire™

Cornus stolonifera 'Farrow'

PP 18,523

H: 5-6' W: 3-4'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 3



Dwarf, compact form with white flowers from May to June. Green foliage turns maroon in fall. In winter, stems are an intense red -its main attraction. Nonsuckering; thrives in wet sites.



Garden Glow™

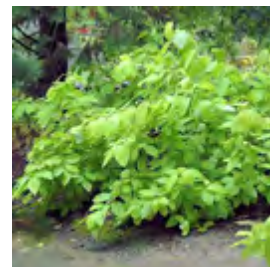
Cornus hesseyii 'Garden Glow'

H: 3-5' W: 3-4'

Part sun/shade

ZONE 4

Rounded form with bright foliage of lime green to golden that turns burgundy in fall. In spring, clusters of small white flowers appear and form small white berries in summer. Red stems stand out in winter snow.



Gray

Cornus racemosa

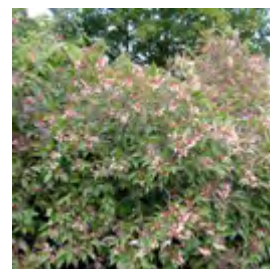
H: 8-10' W: 6-8'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 3



Upright, spreading habit with white flower clusters in the spring followed by showy clusters of white berries in summer. Foliage is light green and turns a dusky purple in the fall. Tolerates a variety of sites. Native.



Isanti

Cornus sericea 'Isanti'

H: 5-6' W: 6-8'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 3

Slow growing with fine branching that forms a dense, compact mound. White flowers in spring form abundant white fruit in summer. Dark green foliage turns maroon in fall. Bright red twigs provide winter interest.



Ivory Halo®

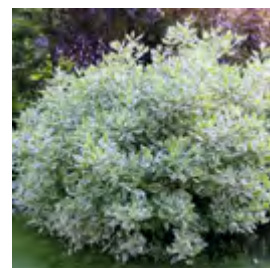
Corus alba 'Bailhalo' PP 8,722

H: 5-6' W: 5-6'

Sun/shade

ZONE 3

Compact form with beautiful variegated foliage in summer and attractive red twigs in winter. Fall coloring varies. Tolerant of a wide range of site conditions, fast growing and prone to suckering.



Kelsey Dwarf

Cornus sericea 'Kelseyi'

H: 2-3' W: 2-3'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 3

Dwarf globe with white flower clusters in late spring followed by white berries. Green foliage turns a strong brick red in fall. Stems are purplish red and quite attractive in winter. Regular pruning helps prevent suckering.



Dogwood

Muskingum®

Cornus racemosa 'Muszam'

H: 2-3' W: 3-5'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 4

Low mounded form with attractive foliage that emerges burgundy in spring, matures to gray-green, then turns burgundy red in fall. White flower clusters in June are followed by white berries. Slow growing and tough.



Prairie Fire

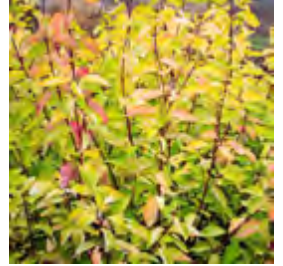
Cornus alba 'Prairie Fire'

H: 5-7' W: 5-7'

Sun/shade

ZONE 3

The bright yellow foliage on this dogwood is retained in the sun but becomes more chartreuse in the shade; turns red in fall. It has small creamy-white flowers in May and white berries in summer. Wet or dry soil.



Red Gnome™

Cornus alba 'Regnzam'

H: 3-4' W: 4-5'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 3

Compact, densely-mounded form has clusters of white flowers in spring that turn to white berries in summer. Dark green summer foliage turns a showy burgundy in fall. Bright red stems. Very resilient and adaptable.



Red Twiggled

Cornus 'Baileyi'

H: 8-10' W: 8-10'

Sun/shade

ZONE 3



Upright, broad spreading habit. White spring flowers are followed by porcelain-blue fruits. Maroon fall color and red stems provide winter interest. Very adaptable to a variety of site conditions including wet or shady.
