

# Heuchera (Coral Bells)

## Berry Smoothie

*Heuchera x 'Berry Smoothie' PP 21,871*

H: 18-20" W: 18-20"  
Part sun/shade

**ZONE 4**

Round lobed foliage is rose-pink turning bronze-red and has a mounded growth habit. Small, bell-shaped ivory flowers bloom in June and are held above the foliage on wiry stems.



## Black Forest Cake

*Heuchera 'Black Forest Cake' PP 33,532*

H: 6-12" W: 12"  
Sun/part shade

**ZONE 4**

Deep purple, almost black foliage is topped with spikes of cherry-red flowers in late spring. Mounded growth habit, fast growing, attracts hummingbirds and is deer resistant.



## Caramel

*Heuchera 'Caramel' PP 16,562*

H: 10-12" W: 12-18"  
Part sun

**ZONE 4**

Golden orange to apricot foliage forms a mound with upright stalks or small, light pink flowers in June and July. Heat and humidity tolerant.



## Citronelle

*Heuchera 'Citronelle' PP 17,934*

H: 10-12" W: 12-14"  
Part sun/shade

**ZONE 4**

Mounds of lime-yellow foliage with silvery undersides have cream colored flowers from May to July. Prefers rich, well-drained soil.



## Fire Alarm

*Heuchera 'Fire Alarm' PP 24,525*

H: 9" W: 14"  
Part sun/shade

**ZONE 4**

Foliage is bright red in spring and darkens to mahogany in summer. Pinkish-white flowers on red stems bloom June to August.



## Forever® Purple

*Heuchera 'TNHEUFP' PP26,358*

H: 10" W: 24"  
Part sun/shade

**ZONE 4**

Short spikes of purple pink flowers appear above the ultra purple, glossy, fluted foliage from May through September. Has a vigorous, multi-crown, mounded habit.



# Heuchera (Coral Bells)

## Frosted Violet

*Heuchera 'Frosted Violet'*

H: 10-14" W: 10-12"

Sun/shade

**ZONE 3**

Rounded, lobed, new leaves emerge pink-purple in spring, turning burgundy-violet. Light pink flowers appear above the foliage in June and July.



## Midnight Rose

*Heuchera 'Midnight Rose' PP*

18,551

H: 10" W: 24"

Part sun

**ZONE 4**

Spreading mound of dark purple foliage with bright pink specks is topped with small, white flowers in spring.



## Northern Exposure™

### Amber

*Heuchera 'TNHEUNEA' PP 29,397*

H: 14-18" W: 18-20"

Part sun

**ZONE 4**

Round amber leaves form a dense mound. Small, yellow flowers are held above the foliage in May and June. Prefers well-drained soil.



## Northern Exposure™

### Black

*Heuchera 'TNHEUNEB' PP 30,583*

H: 10" W: 24"

Sun/Shade

**ZONE 3**

Ruffled, maroon-black leaves with red undersides form a dense mound. Foliage remains fresh late into the season. Tall, dainty white flowers bloom from May to June.



## Northern Exposure™

### Lime

*Heuchera 'TNHEUNEL' PP 29,162*

H: 16-20" W: 18-24"

Part sun

**ZONE 4**

Round lime green leaves form a broad mound. Soft red flowers appear in early summer. Tolerates extreme temperatures and has good longevity in the landscape.



## Northern Exposure™

### Red

*Heuchera 'TNHEUNER' PP 29,420*

H: 14-18" W: 18-20"

Part sun

**ZONE 4**

Round dark red foliage forms a dense mound. Small, yellow flowers are held above the foliage in May and June. Prefers well-drained soil.



# Heuchera (Coral Bells)

## Palace Purple

*Heuchera micrantha 'Palace Purple'*

H: 18-24" W: 24"

Sun/shade

**ZONE 3**

Ivy-like, deep mahogany-red foliage forms a large mound. Small white flowers bloom from May to June. Larger in leaf and stature, hardier, and more sun tolerant than others.



## Paris

*Heuchera x 'Paris' PP 18,881*

H: 10-12" W: 12-14"

Part sun

**ZONE 3**

Green foliage with silver overlay and deep rose pink flowers that bloom from May to July. Flowers are showier and stand out against the foliage.



## Plum Pudding

*Heuchera 'Plum Pudding'*

H: 12" W: 15"

Part sun

**ZONE 4**

Shiny, dark purple foliage with a silver overlay and small white flowers bloom in June and July. Forms an upright mound.
