

# Lilac (Tree Form)

## **Bloomerang®**

*Syringa 'Penda' PP 20,575*

H: 6-8' W: 4-5'

Full sun

**ZONE 3**



Compact, rounded growth habit, grafted onto a standard. Purple-pink, ultra fragrant flowers are heaviest in spring, then rebloom throughout the summer and into the fall. Powdery mildew and deer resistant.



## **Dwarf Korean**

*Syringa meyeri 'Palibin'*

H: 6-8' W: 5-6'

Full sun

**ZONE 4**

A compact, round globe grafted onto a standard. Very fragrant, pale violet flowers are abundant from late May into June and contrast nicely with the dark green foliage.



## **Ivory Silk®**

*Japanese Syringa reticulata*

*'Ivory Silk'*

H: 25' W: 15'

Full sun

**ZONE 3**

Sturdy, compact, oval growth habit. It blooms later than most other species of lilac, with large, fragrant, creamy white flower clusters in mid-June through mid-July. Dark green foliage and cherry-like bark give it multiple seasons of interest. Available in clump or single stem tree form.



## **Miss Kim**

*Syringa patula 'Miss Kim'*

H: 6-8' W: 4-5'

Full sun

**ZONE 3**

Upright and compact form with fragrant, lilac-pink flowers that bloom in June. The leaves are dark green and wavy and turn burgundy-red in the fall. Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Mildew resistant.
