Flame

Miscanthus sinensis 'Purpurascens'

H: 48" W: 48"

Full Sun

ZONE 4

Tight, upright clumps of green with a red tint turn red-orange in fall. In late summer, large, silvery plumes appear. Slow to emerge in spring. Adaptable to many soil types.



Huron Sunrise

Miscanthus sinensis 'Huron Sunrise'

H: 60-72" W: 36"

Full Sun

ZONE 4

Green w/silver mid-ribs develop very full, burgundy seedheads in late summer and become silvery-white plumes by fall. Foliage turns golden in autumn. Drought tolerant.



Porcupine

Miscanthus sinensis 'Strictus'

H: 72-84" W: 36-48"

Full Sun

ZONE 4/5

Green foliage with horizontal golden bands, and reddish bronze plumes in summer. Rigid, upright habit and stiff, pointed leaf blades like porcupine quills. Drought tolerant.
