## Amber Jubilee™

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Jefam'*

PP 23,177

H: 5-6' W: 4'

Full Sun

ZONE 2



Compact growth habit that is less prone to suckering. Button-like whitish-pink flowers in June. Most noted for its foliage color: glowing tones of yellow, orange & gold, followed by purple & red in fall.



## Dart's Gold

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Dart's Gold'*

H: 4-5' W: 4-5'

Full Sun

ZONE 2

More refined, compact growing form with deeply lobed golden foliage that takes on a golden hue with a bronze tint in fall. Dense clusters of small, white flowers adorn the branches in spring and are followed by red fruit.



## Diablo®

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Monlo'*

PP 11,211

H: 8-10' W: 8-10'

Full Sun

ZONE 3

Intense reddish-purple foliage on upright, arching branches. Clusters of creamy-white flowers during the summer add contrast. Tolerant of harsh conditions and acidic soils.



## Lemon Candy

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Podaras3'* PP 22,362

H: 3' W: 3'

Full Sun

ZONE 3

Dwarf, compact form with yellow-gold foliage. Charming white blooms appear in June on upright, bushy branches. Tough and durable; cold hardy and disease resistant, as well as, heat and drought tolerant.



## Little Devil™

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Donna May'* PP 22,634

H: 5-6' W: 4-5'

Full Sun

ZONE 3



White-pink, button-like flowers in June adorn the upright spreading branches and fine textured, dark foliage. Stems glow red and leaves turn green on the interior of the plant. Powdery mildew resistant.



## Spicy Devil®

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Zlenatalie'* PP 34,244

H: 3-4' W: 3-4'

Full Sun

ZONE 4



Leaves emerge a fiery combination of orange and yellow before maturing to a vibrant reddish-purple. Whitepink flowers are abundant in June. It has an upright rounded form and is drought tolerant.

## Summer Wine®

*Physocarpus opulifolius 'Seward'*

PP 14,821

H: 6-8' W: 5'

Full Sun

**ZONE 4**



Neat, compact branching habit and fine, deeply cut, dark crimson-red leaves. Pinkish-white flowers in midsummer show nicely against the dark foliage. Adapts to many soil conditions, and is also mildew resistant.
