Early Gold

Pyrus x 'Jefgold' COPF

H: 25' W: 20'

Full Sun

ZONE 3

Abundant showy white flowers in spring produce fruit with a consistent oval shape, small, high quality, greenish fruit in early August. Very resistant to fire blight. Performs best with a pollinator.



Golden Spice

Pyrus ussuriensis 'Golden Spice'

H: 18' W: 12'

Full Sun

ZONE 3

White flowers in spring produce small, firm, yellow with light blush fruit that ripens in late August. The pears have a sweet taste and a crisp texture. Self-pollinating, higher yield with a pollinator. Fire blight resistant.



Juicy Jewel® Asian

Pyrus 'MN121' PP 35,551

H: 10-15' W: 8-12'

Full Sun

ZONE 4

A cold-hardy variety developed by the University of Minnesota, known for its crisp, apple-like texture and sweet flavor with mild tropical overtones. Blooms in April and ripens mid-August. Requires pollinator that blooms at the same time.



Parker

Pyrus 'Parker'

H: 15' W: 10-12'

Full Sun

ZONE 4

Open-pollinated seedling of a Manchurian pear has white flowers in spring. Large, yellow-bronze fruit in August is fine grained, tender and juicy. Upright and vigorous grower.



Summercrisp

Pyrus 'Summercrisp'

H: 15' W: 10-12'

Full Sun

ZONE 4

May flowers produce fruit in August when crisp and still green with a red blush. Fruit is sweet and crisp, and may be stored for up to 2 months. An annual bearer that is free of fire blight. Use Parker as a pollinator.
