ZONE 3

Spreading clumps of blue foliage turn red, burgundy, & purple in fall. Reddish purple seed heads appear in September and October. Drought tolerant.



Chameleon

H: 18-24" W: 18-24"

Full Sun

ZONE 3

White and green striped leaves appear in early spring. In late summer, it develops a strong flush of pink and purple. Compact habit, salt and drought tolerant; low maintenance.



Little Bluestem

H: 30-36" W: 15"

Full Sun

ZONE 4



Blue foliage turns a rich orange in fall and purple-red seed heads bloom from August to September. Forms upright clumps. Tolerates wet sites. Native.



Standing Ovation

H: 36-48" W: 24"

Sun/part shade

ZONE 3

Blue-green foliage turns brilliant shades of orange and red in fall. Silver flower spikes bloom in September. Forms upright, sturdy clumps. Drought tolerant.
